General Revenue

General Revenue collections for November totaled \$342,495,269, **exceeding** the monthly estimate of \$322,442,000 by \$20,053,269. Bringing the total year to date General Revenue collections to \$1,937,278,210.

As of the end of November the state has collected 42% of its total estimated yearly revenue of \$4,574,514,000. At this time, the state should have collected 39% of its yearly revenue. This current trend puts the state **on track** for meeting yearly revenue estimates.

Personal Income Tax

Personal income tax (PIT) collections for the month were \$149,830,002. This figure is \$14,830,002 above the November estimate of \$135,000,000. The total year to date personal income tax collections for fiscal year 2021 are \$923,821,966.

As of the end of November the state has collected 43% of its total estimated PIT yearly collections of \$2,004,000,000. At this time the state should have collected 41% of its PIT yearly collections. This current trend puts the state **on track** for meeting the PIT yearly collections estimate.

Severance Tax

Severance tax collections for November were \$21,020,291. This figure is \$5,279,709 **below** the monthly estimate of \$26,300,000. Total severance tax collections for fiscal year 2021 are \$54,210,003.

As of the end of November the state has collected 22% of its total yearly collections of \$361,700,000. At this time the state should have collected 19% of its yearly severance tax collections. This current trend puts the state **on track** for meeting the yearly severance tax collection estimate.

Other Notable Collections

Consumer Sales and Service Tax collections for the month were \$6,661,444 **above** the November estimate of \$127,000,000 at \$133,611,444.

Tobacco Products Tax collections for November were \$12,576,403. These collections were **below** the monthly estimate of \$12,600,000 by \$23,597.

Lottery

Total gross lottery collections for October were \$93,978,000. This figure is \$13,297,000 **above** the monthly estimate of \$80,681,000. Total gross lottery collections for fiscal year 2021 are \$372,862,000.
