General Revenue

General Revenue collections for September totaled \$423,620,749*, **exceeding** the monthly estimate of \$413,589,000 by \$10,031,749. Bringing the total year to date General Revenue collections to \$1,238,988,743.

As of the end of September the state has collected 27% of its total estimated yearly revenue of \$4,574,514,000. At this time, the state should have collected 25% of its yearly revenue.

*The total General Revenue collections figure of \$423 million represents actual September collections.

Personal Income Tax

Personal income tax (PIT) collections for the month were \$193,981,792. This figure is \$2,018,208 **above** the September estimate of \$196,000,000. The total year to date personal income tax collections for fiscal year 2021 are \$614,485,771.

As of the end of September the state has collected 29% of its total estimated PIT yearly collections of \$2,155,650,000. At this time the state should have collected 27% of its PIT yearly collections. This current trend puts the state **on track** for meeting the PIT yearly collections estimate.

Consumer Sales and Service Tax

Collections of the Consumer Sales and Service Tax (CS&S) for the month of September were \$129,313,005 and were \$813,005 **above** the monthly estimate of \$128,500,000. Total Consumer Sales and Service Tax collections for fiscal year 2021 are \$350,728,087.

As of the month of September the state has collected 25% of its yearly estimated collections. At this time the state should have collected 24% of its yearly estimate. This current trend puts the state **on** track for meeting the yearly CS&S tax collection estimate.

Severance Tax

Severance tax collections for September were \$18,571,955. This figure is \$5,828,045 **below** the monthly estimate of \$24,400,000. Total severance tax collections for fiscal year 2021 are \$22,614,471.

As of the end of September the state has collected 9% of its total yearly collections of \$250,950,000. At this time the state should have collected 7% of its yearly severance tax collections. This current trend puts the state **on track** for meeting the yearly severance tax collection estimate.

Lottery

Total lottery collections for August were \$93,672,000. This figure is \$9,932,000 **above** the monthly estimate of \$83,740,000. Total lottery collections for fiscal year 2021 are \$187,579.

** These numbers are not final and are as reported through WVOasis on October 1, 2020. They have been formally released by the Governor's Budget Office.

*** The July revenue report did not include the \$68.6 million borrowed from the Rainy Day Fund in it's reporting of General Revenue collections. This report adds that \$68.6 million back into General Revenue collections to reflect actual collections for the month of September, before that money was deducted to pay the loan. You can see this deduction represented in the OASIS report.

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
