General Revenue

General Revenue collections for November totaled \$322,904,067, **falling below** the monthly estimate of \$330,128,000 by \$7,223,933. Bringing the total year to date General Revenue collections to \$1,775,307,881.

As of the end of November the state has collected 38% of its total estimated yearly revenue of \$4,710,200,000. At this time, the state should have collected 39% of its yearly revenue. This current trend puts the state **not on track** for meeting yearly revenue estimates.

Personal Income Tax

Personal income tax (PIT) collections for the month were \$137,650,558. This figure is \$1,449,442 **below** the November estimate of \$139,100,000. The total year to date personal income tax collections for fiscal year 2020 are \$798,790,866.

As of the end of November the state has collected 37% of its total estimated PIT yearly collections of \$2,154,880,000. At this time the state should have collected 38% of its PIT yearly collections. This current trend puts the state **not on track** for meeting the PIT yearly collections estimate.

Consumer Sales and Service Tax

Collections of the Consumer Sales and Service Tax (CS&S) for the month of November were \$124,305,836 and were \$745,836 **above** the monthly estimate of \$123,560,000. Total Consumer Sales and Service Tax collections for fiscal year 2020 are \$555,778,039.

As of the month of November the state has collected 39.98% of its yearly estimated collections. At this time the state should have collected 40.10% of its yearly estimate. This current trend puts the state **not on** track for meeting the yearly CS&S tax collection estimate.

Severance Tax

Severance tax collections for November were \$25,695,615. This figure is \$4,804,385 **below** the monthly estimate of \$30,500,000. Total severance tax collections for fiscal year 2020 are \$93,106,533.

As of the end of November the state has collected 25% of its total yearly collections of \$376,800,000. At this time the state should have collected 35% of its yearly severance tax collections. This current trend puts the state **not on track** for meeting the yearly severance tax collection estimate.
